The City of Blaine is seeking [Request for Qualifications](#) from artists in the first phase of the Lighthouse Park public art project selection process. This project is being administered by the [Blaine Art Advisory Committee](#) who will be reviewing the artist's submissions in this first phase and selecting a small group of artists as finalists. In the second phase, the artists will be asked to provide a more in-depth project description in order to select the two final art pieces. The two art pieces will be installed at the Lighthouse Park Water Reclamation Facility by the grand opening scheduled for June 2010. The Request for Qualification submissions are due by **Friday, October 23, 2009, by 5:00 pm (PDT)**.
